8:30 am – 11:30 am Avoiding Due Process Hearings w/ Sarah Sutherland, Attorney

This session will provide an explanation and discuss the procedures the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) requires for school districts and parents to determine an individual student’s educational plan, and discuss how these procedures may be used most effectively for the benefits of the individual student and the school districts who are responsible to serve them and all other students. Join us in exploring how school districts and the special education teachers and related service providers they employ can maximize the procedures the IDEA requires short of due process hearings and compliance reviews.

1:00 pm – 4:00 pm Surviving Due Process Hearings w/ Sarah Sutherland, Attorney

This session will engage participants in discussion of how due process hearings required by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and participating in them can lead to educational benefits to the student for whom the hearing is about, and others in your school district. It will also engage in discussion of how the procedural safeguards of the IDEA can be used to make educational programming better for the student at issue, as well as all other students served by the school district and employees who testify and are able to learn from the experience. Testifying in a due process hearing, even the thought of it, can be daunting. This session focuses on harnessing that angst to prepare towards positive ends for all students and avoiding the need to testify again!
